Disciplinary Steps

- Each child starts with a bonus of 100 points for the year. The learner can either accumulate (maximum 1000 points) or lose points (0). Points must be carried over from the one term to the next.
- 2. Prayers and two counselling sessions with the registered Aunt/Uncle
- 3. Refer to Chaplain for counselling sessions (1 month) parents receive an sms to alert them and a note in the diary to be signed by the parents . Friday detention and extra work homework (Class teacher must provide the work) from 13h00-14h30. The Office will supervise.
- 4. Parents must be called in to the Office. Friday cleaning up and extra homework
- 5. One week suspension
- 6. (Must see a qualified psychologist report to be sent to the school) Learner not allowed to attend any outings /extra-murals arranged by the school for that particular term.
- 7. Expulsion warning letter send home to the parents
- 8. Expulsion
